- people of Sitamadhi district to fight with the ill-effects of floods, using local techniques, to a reasonable extent.
- Making of motorized boat and small boats for rescuing the flood affected people. (One big motorized boat and four small boats have been made.)
- Preparation of temporary shelters for the flood victims. (Three shelters had been constructed at Parsurampur, Nilami mushar tola and Gajpati Kanhauli).
- Providing psychological support and counseling to the flood affected victims and traumatized people.
- Formation of special village level subcommittees for managing different activities of disaster preparedness like -VVC,VDMC, Health and Hygiene, Fist aid, TBA etc., with appropriate training and equipments to tackle the situation.
- 300 Trained volunteers with appropriate life saving equipments
- Mass awareness/advocacy campaign on the needs of Community Based Disaster Preparedness

3. Institutional Building

With the support of TDH-Germany, Save the Children, UK, the organization has formed institutions like,

- 50 SHGs were formed at Belsand Block, Sitamadhi District, where the women are engaged in different developmental works which further enhanced their decisionmaking process.
- 'Bal-Panchayats' formation for strengthening the voice of children and for enabling them to solve their problems themselves.
- Making 'Farmers Club' for the farmers so that they can come together and discuss the various issues of farming. (10 Farmers Club had been made by the SGSS).
- Beside these various committees had been made to tackle the flood and hence reducing the Post-Flood epidemics.

4. Welfare Programme for Marginalized Population

- Apart from the women and children, the organization is also working for the restoration of rights for the SCs & STs who are the most vulnerable people of the society.
- Advocacy for these downtrodden peoples is the basic work done by this organization.

5. Health programmes

- With the support with Action Aid, in the year 2005, the organization had taken care of 60 families in districts Vaishali, that were suffering from Kala-azar and distributed 60 wooden bed and mosquito net to the 'Mushar' community. A part from this, we have advocate for special Indira Awas and it has been provided to the victim families by the district administration.
- The organization also provided them i.e. all 60 families two months ration free of cost. The organization with Action Aid support, organized a Kala-azar advocacy meeting in Raipur, Vaishali.
- The organization has also taken steps in the field of community health in districts of Sitamadhi and Vaishali. Free medical camps were organized in villages Bhulli and Sarkhuli of Parsauni block and villages Maheshpur, Partappur and Block office of Belsand block of Sitamadhi district.
- The organization is also engaged in the smooth and good maintenance of hospitals in Katihar district. The organization ensures that the entire function i.e. basic infrastructure is working properly.
- We are also engaged for the awareness of female foitecide in sheohar district with the support of Plan & BVHA.
- We are also engaged in awareness and prevention of TB disease in Vaishali and Katihar District with the support of BVHA Patna.
- An innovative programme for the awareness

of AIDS towards the MSM in district Siwan & Gopalganj.

6. Educational programme -

• The organization had run 12 alternatives and innovative schools in different part of kadwa block of Katihar district through the support of the district programme office. This programme was for the children who left their studies or never been to school i.e. the side line children from the education. In this programme we had taught 300 children of the age group 6-14, who generally belong to extreme backward community.

7. Other Activities

- Multi beneficial social forestry programme was carried out at Deoghar District, Jharkhand in which horticultural tree like Mango were promoted with the farmers. This is called multi beneficial because it restores the environment damaged from pollution, it binds the soil from erosion as the slope gradient in the area is relatively higher, it also improves the soil texture and maintains its fertility It also provides additional income to the people. A total of 3000 plants were planted in the area.
- The organization has carried out an 'education for all' drive in 15 villages of Hajipur block of Vaishli district. This drive basically focused on the education of adults particularly the daily earners. This drive was carried out for 3 months in which 268 adults were taught.
- SGSS also organize the Gram Shree Mela, which is a 10 days Mela programme, which is organized by CAPART under ministry of rural development for promoting the rural product.
- The organization also organized the psycho-social counseling for the adolescent and children at Narpantganj block of Araria district Bihar. Nearly 350 adolescents and children who became traumatized during floods were

- identified and provided counseling.
- Beside these, consumer awareness and protection programme, Health & family planning programme, drug-de-addiction programme (At Vaishali district), natural resource management program, blindness eradication program, Social forestry & plantation programme etc were also organized by this organization.

8. Science and Technology

 SGSS has approached department of science and technology, Govt. of India to establish village knowledge centers. The project is under consideration after first round of presentation before the selection committee.
